MAJOR TECHNOLOGICAL INTERVENTIONS

- •Assessment of different biological control agents for the management of downy mildew (*Pseudoperonospora cubensis*) on cucurbits

 Protective licorice extract application resulted in stable high efficacies even under semi-commercial conditions.
- •Assessment of different biological control agents and herbal based repellents for the management of termites in sugarcane crop

EPN performed well in recording the low termites incidence and higher economic return.

- •Assessing the effect of sampoorna in cowpea cultivation
 Sampoorna trial plot showed better result in yield, management of
 nutrient deficiencies
- •Assessing the effect of customized fertilizer formulation in Tapioca and Amorphophallus intercropped

Customized fertilizer-1 @ 500 kg/ha showed better result in respect of Good cooking quality, growth and yield.

•Assessment of different innovative technologies for deterring crop raiding wild elephants

Krishi Rakshak LED light placed area of small cardamom plantation was observed crop raiding wild elephant not entered in the field.

•Assessment of different biological control agents for the management of thrips (Sciothrips cardamomi) in small cardamom

Spraying of *Lecanicillium psalliotae* in small cardamom field resulted in reduced population of thrips when compared with *Steinernema* field.
